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**Should the Reintegration  
Affect Your Sites Column?**

- The short answer is: NO
- Sites should continue to monitor their regulatory performance
- Findings that exist prior to the reintegration will show up on the website
- Sites should be prepared to address these issues when the website changes



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**Communications**

- NRC will have their own set of communications on the reintegration.
- Do **not** rely on these communications with your stakeholders.
- Identify your key stakeholders (e.g. plant mgt., public, local & state gov't.).
- Develop a communications plan to explain what's happening and what to expect from both a process and site-specific perspective.



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### Key Messages

- The process is not new, and we have been addressing the issues as they have arisen.
- If you have current issues that will show up on the website, address them proactively and explain in general terms that you are already working on them.
- **NOTE: you should not give out any more information than is released through the NRC website or reports/letters (e.g. no discussion of colors/significance).**



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### Questions to Consider

- Have your Security and/or Licensing Directors briefed plant/utility management?
- Have you identified your key stakeholders for this change?
- Do you have a change management/communications plan for the change?



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
