SUBJECT: STAFF REQUIREMENTS – COMSECY-09-0008 – PERIODIC  
UPDATE ON THE TECHNOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENTS  
CONCERNING THE NATIONAL SOURCE TRACKING SYSTEM

The Commission has approved the staff proposal to discontinue the periodic updates regarding activities related to technological developments and the efforts of other federal agencies involved in tracking radioactive materials.

Since the Nuclear Government Coordinating Committee (NGCC) Radioisotope Sub Council is now responsible for exploring technological enhancements for tracking technologies and has assigned lead responsibility to the U.S. Department of Transportation and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Transportation Security Administration, the staff should remain actively involved in the NGCC Radioisotope Sub Council efforts related to this topic.

The staff should utilize existing formal and informal mechanisms to report new developments in this area to the Commission.
