The proceedings involved Kerr-McGee's application for a license amendment authorizing disposal of 18

mill tailings by onsite burial at it West Chicago Rare Earths facility. All parties agree that this proceeding is moot because Kerr-McGee no longer intends to pursue onsite disposal. All of you have approved this order and let me ask you to affirm your votes.

COMMISSIONER DICUS: Aye. MR. HOYLE: Thank you.
